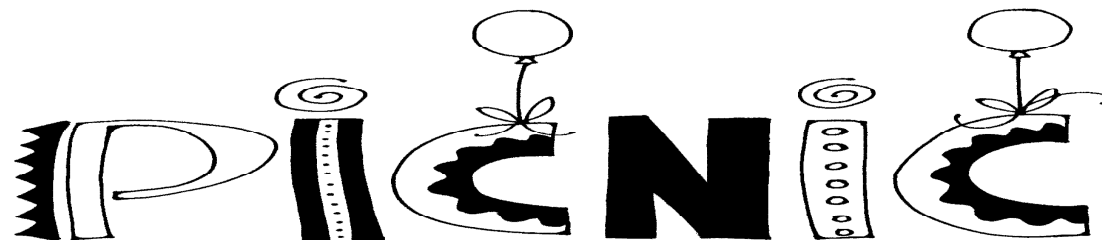
A STEPHEN SERIES CONGREGATION
